

PRACTICE HEAD CARE & CLEANING

Thank you for purchasing a Mehron practice head from Paintertainment! Practice heads are fantastic for working out new designs! Every practice head does stain over time. However, there are ways that you can prevent staining, and ways that you can clean your head to make it look almost as good as new!

PREVENTING STAINS



Before painting on your practice head, spray it with a coat of hairspray. Any brand will do! Allow it to dry fully, and then repeat. Do this before each time you paint to help prevent stains.



After using your practice head, STOP! Do NOT rinse it with water yet! For whatever reason, starting with water tends to set stains on practice heads. First, rub some liquid hand soap on your head, swirling it around with your fingertips until all of the paint has been loosened and lifted. THEN rinse away the soap and paint with water.

REMOVING STAINS



Purchase some isopropyl alcohol (90% or higher), and a Magic Eraser.



Pour a little alcohol onto the Magic Eraser.



Press and swirl the wet Magic Eraser around the head to remove stains!

How to clean the cracks & crevices...



Press the eraser into the cracks, leaving a little pool of alcohol behind.



Use an old toothbrush to scrub the cracks.



Rinse and enjoy your nice, clean canvas!
